Notes

Took Cooper to Mountain View Cemetery again we could see dogs from a distance and practice “this way” and turn around. Did a lot of loose leash walking around cemetery and in neighborhood and watched Cooper’s body language to make sure we turned away from dogs before he zeroed in on them. At home, practiced having Cooper laying next to me quietly while I sat at the table and bar in kitchen – reinforced quiet, calm behavior. Reinforcing good focus in non-distracting environment.

Cooper very calm and good with off-leash walking and practicing his focus exercises – he’s calming down very quickly and is happy and eager to learn. Mental stimulation is great for him.

Instructions

Continue to work on exercises given last week. Continue to try to keep other on-leash dogs at least 30-50’ away when possible. Reinforce him for quiet, calm behavior in the house. Keep an eye on his body language so you can see when he tenses up and remove him from the situation before he has a chance to react.
